Summer camp is a great way for participants to develop an interest and greater understanding of our relationship with the horse. By participating in daily riding lessons, learning about horse management hands on, viewing mounted and unmounted demonstrations, and getting creative with projects, young campers build a correct and proper foundation in horsemanship. Summer camp is also a great opportunity for the young riders to build their own confidence and broaden friendships with both horses and other riders.

As a recognized USPC Riding Center, Rocky River Farm strives to provide the highest quality of instruction for young riders that allows them to learn correctly and progressively in a safe manner.

There are 2 sessions :

Session I June 14th - 18th

Session II August 2nd - 6th

Camp hours:

9:00 am - 4:00 pm Monday- Thursday

9:00 am- 1:00 pm Friday

1:00 pm Friday parents arrive for open house, mounted games, and refreshments

Camp fee:

\$400.00 per session (this includes a \$100.00 non-refundable processing fee)

Camp is for anyone aged 6 years and older. Participants will be grouped according to skill level and ride school horses appropriate for their level. Participants may bring their own horse for an extra **\$25 per session**. Participants should wear long pants, boots with a small heel, and their own helmet or can be provided with one.

Rocky River Farm is located at **2025 N Russell Rd, Bloomington IN 47408**. From the Highway 45/46 by-pass, travel north-east 1 1/2 miles, turn north onto Russell Rd. The barn is just 1/4 north on the left.
